To whom it may concern.

I would like to voice my opinion on how repeat traffic offenders are sentenced in NSW.

They should lose their license for longer periods.

Eg. 1<sup>st</sup> offence = 6 month suspension  
2<sup>nd</sup> offense = 1 year suspension  
3<sup>rd</sup> offense = lifetime loss of license

If at any time they receive an offense whilst suspended, it is an automatic loss of license for a lifetime. Driving is a privilege, not a right! As a nurse working in an emergency department, I believe this would really cut down on the amount of critical injuries and death due to motor vehicle accidents, as people would be more careful on our roads.

This rule should change if you are in an urban or regional area. If you do the wrong thing, you are punished. Public transport is pretty much non-existent in regional/rural areas, so this should give greater incentive to those people to obey the law.
