I am writing to express my support of the #yourreferenceaintrelevant campaign. I am of the belief that most child sexual predators are masters of compartmentalism. The reputation and behaviours that they present to adults is carefully crafted as to not raise suspicion of their wrongdoings. Child sexual abusers can be skilled in manipulation and coercion, and in many cases these people put a concerted effort into gaining access to their victim unbeknownst to the protectors of that child. These efforts take place in many forms such as online, through trusted adults of the child, in environments that are typically child friendly and even in public spaces under the guise of innocent interactions. I argue that child sexual predators are incapable of possessing a "good character" as they operate on the basis of taking advantage of a societal and physiological power imbalance.
