Dear Mr Cripps

Thank you for forwarding to the Community Relations Commission the consultation paper *Sentencing Serious Violent Offenders* dated May 2011, for comment. The Commission offers the following in response to the consultation.

Cultural diversity is not a relevant factor in determining attributes of cohorts in the context of serious violent offenders, nor for any such category of offenders. It is in this context that the Commission notes with approval that ethnicity of offenders is not a factor for consideration in the subject matter of the consultation paper.

Contained within the consultation paper is a reference to the opportunity for offenders to participate in rehabilitation programs. Such programs must be offered and conducted in a manner that is culturally appropriate to the recipient to enhance the chances of achieving successful outcomes.

Offenders in the correctional system must have appropriate access to interpreting and translation services. This is especially important in the context of respect of rights and responsibilities whenever significant decisions are to be made about an inmate's living conditions, access to programs and services, or sentencing.

The Commission looks forward to receiving information on the outcomes of the consultation.
